

GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS (ORAL, POSTER, AND ARTICLE ABSTRACTS)

Turkish Journal of Immunology Supplementary Issue

Format: Manuscripts should be prepared in Microsoft Word, on A4-sized pages with 2.5 cm margins on all sides, using 12-point Arial font and 1.5 line spacing.

Abbreviations: Abbreviations should be defined at first mention and used consistently thereafter. Only internationally accepted abbreviations should be used; authors are encouraged to refer to standard scientific writing guides when necessary.

Title Page: The title page should include the title of the manuscript, short title, author names, and author information. The following items should appear in the order given below:

- Full title of the manuscript (in English), as concise and explanatory as possible, without abbreviations (maximum 135 characters)
- Full names and surnames of the authors (without abbreviations or academic titles) and their institutional affiliations
- Name, address, e-mail, and telephone number of the corresponding author
- ORCID iDs of all authors

Abstract: For original articles, the abstract should be structured and limited to a maximum of 300 words. It should include the following subheadings: Objective, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusion, and Keywords. References should not be cited in the abstract. The use of abbreviations should be avoided as much as possible.

Keywords: Provide a minimum of three and a maximum of six keywords, selected in accordance with the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) of the U.S. National Library of Medicine database.

References: References should follow the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) style (see: <http://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/books/bv.fcgi?rid=citmed.TOC&depth=2>).

References must be numbered consecutively in the order they are cited in the main text, and cited in parentheses using Arabic numerals.

Additional Guidelines for the Supplementary Issue

Submission Type and Review Policy:

This supplementary issue includes abstracts of oral and poster presentations, as well as original article abstracts accepted for the scientific meeting. Submissions are not peer-reviewed, but are editorially screened for clarity, structure, and compliance with ethical and publication standards.

Ethical Responsibility:

Authors are responsible for ensuring that their abstracts comply with ethical research principles and do not contain identifiable patient information.

Language:

All abstracts must be written in clear and grammatical English. Standard scientific terminology should be used consistently.

Conflict of Interest:

Any potential conflicts of interest or funding sources should be disclosed at the end of the abstract.
